

### **SAFETY GEAR**

Wearing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required while operating on our property.

#### SAFETY GOGGLES

Protective eyewear must be worn at all times.



#### **VEST**

High visibility vests must be worn at all times.

#### **GLOVES**

Gloves designed to protect hands from sharp metal objects are required while handling reels, dunnage, strapping, chain pullers, chains, binders, straps, and cargo restraint bars.


#### **FOOTWEAR**

Close-toed footwear must be worn at all times. Open-toed shoes (Sandals, flip flops, crocs, etc.) are not to be worn.

# SAFETY PRACTICES

Maintain a safe distance from any ongoing loading or unloading activities to ensure personal safety.

- Drivers and assistants may not enter the identified RED zone around the truck during active loading.
- 2 Drivers and assistants should remain in the cab of the truck or in designated 'Safe Area'. The safe areas will vary by plant but should be clearly marked.
